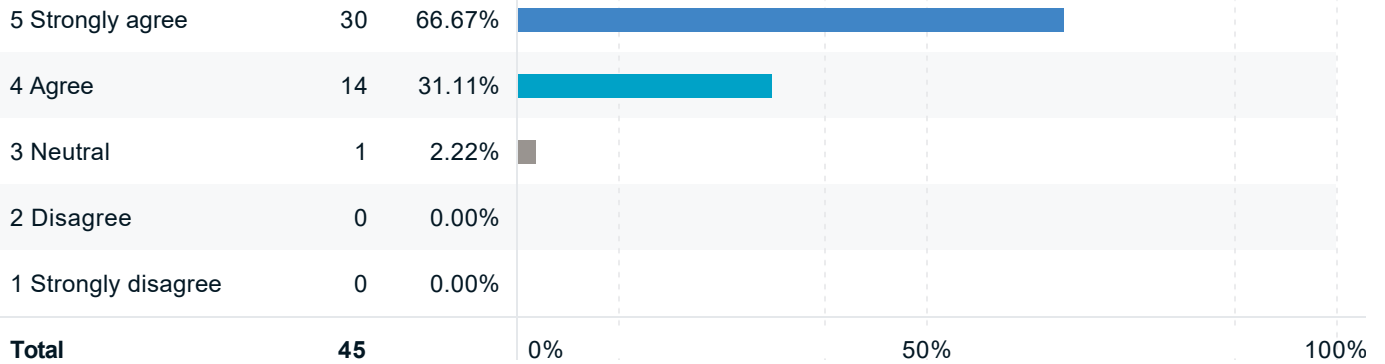

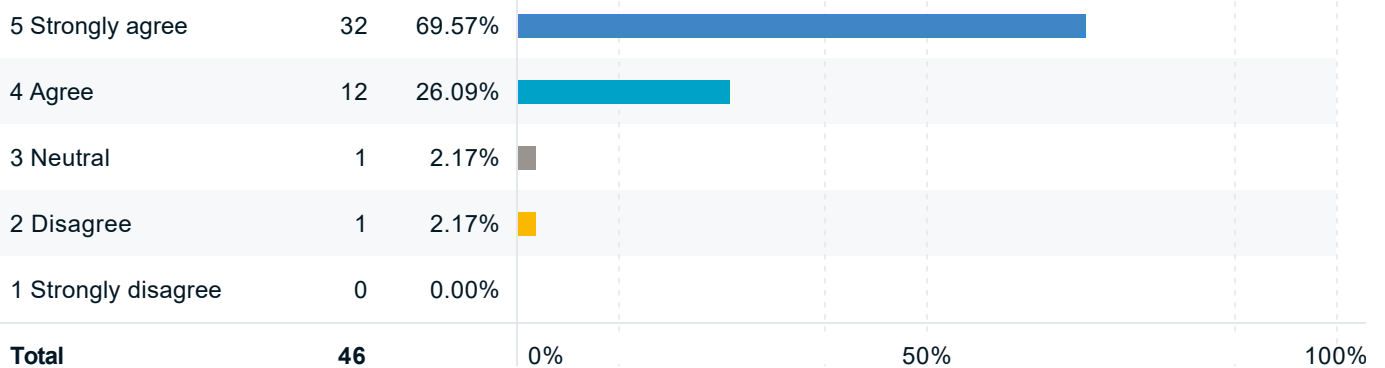

1. I had a clear understanding of the aims and goals of the course.



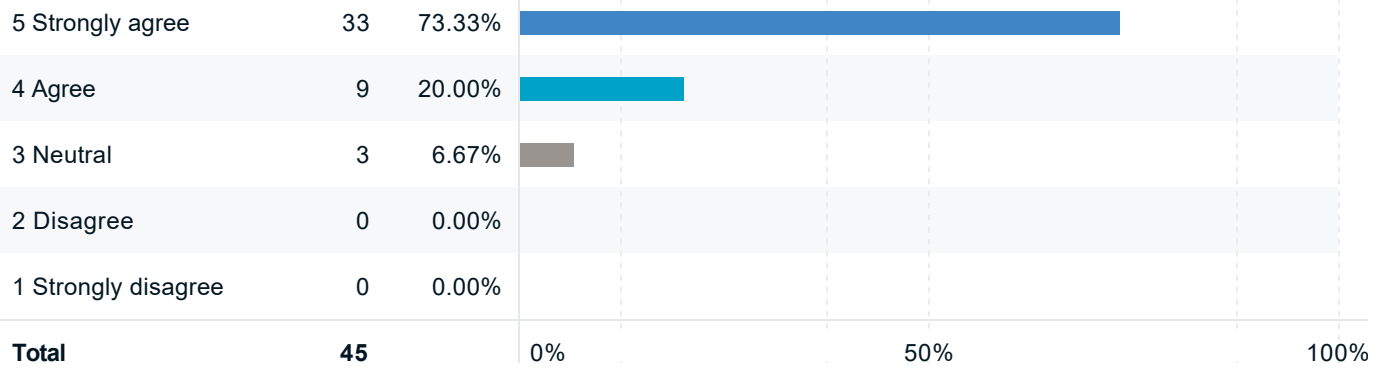

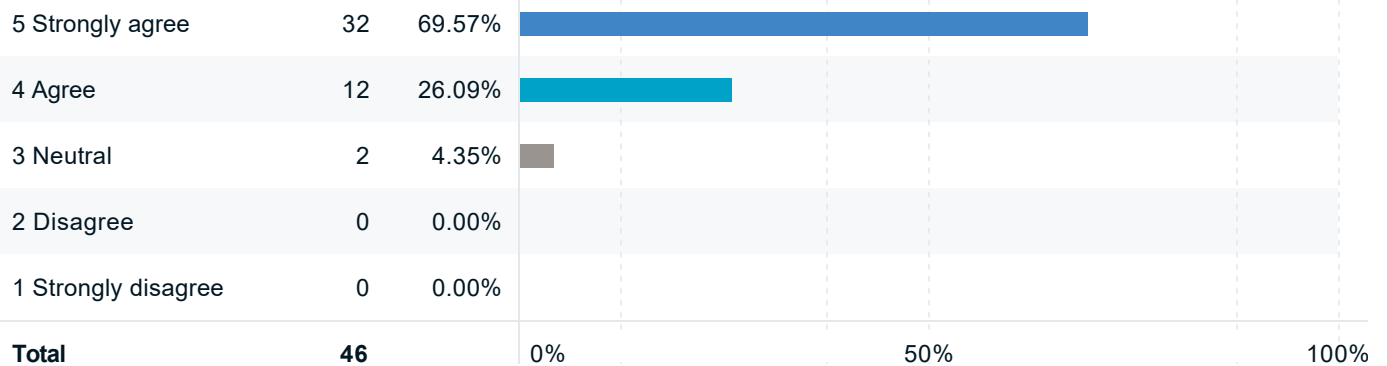

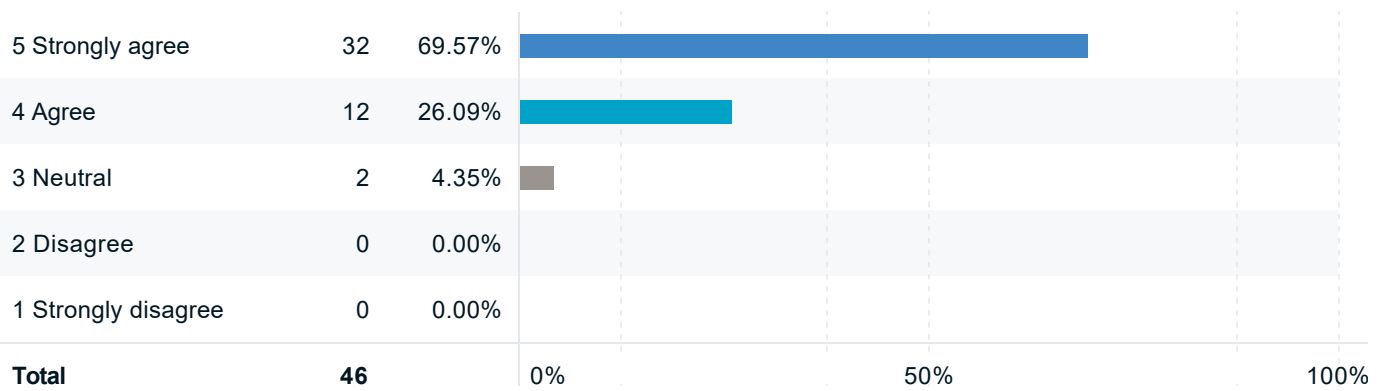

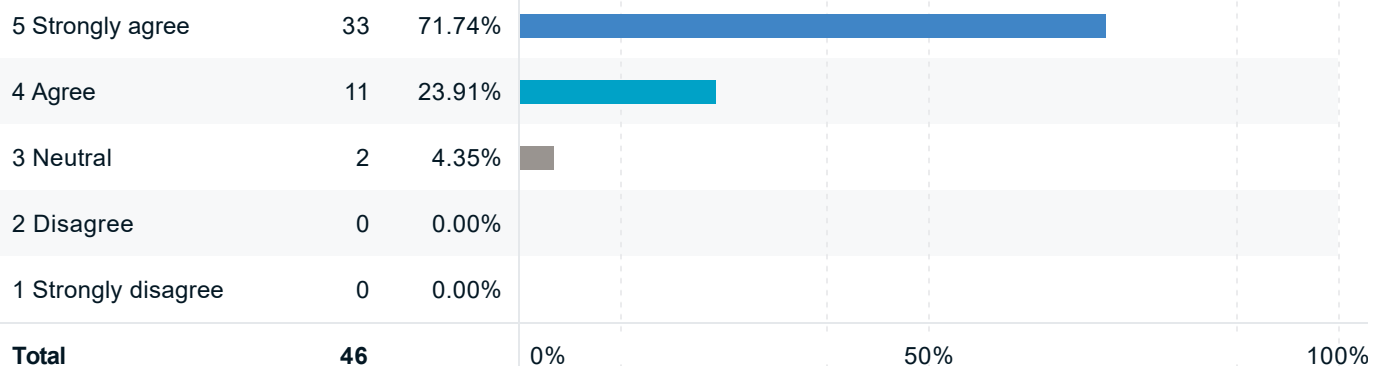

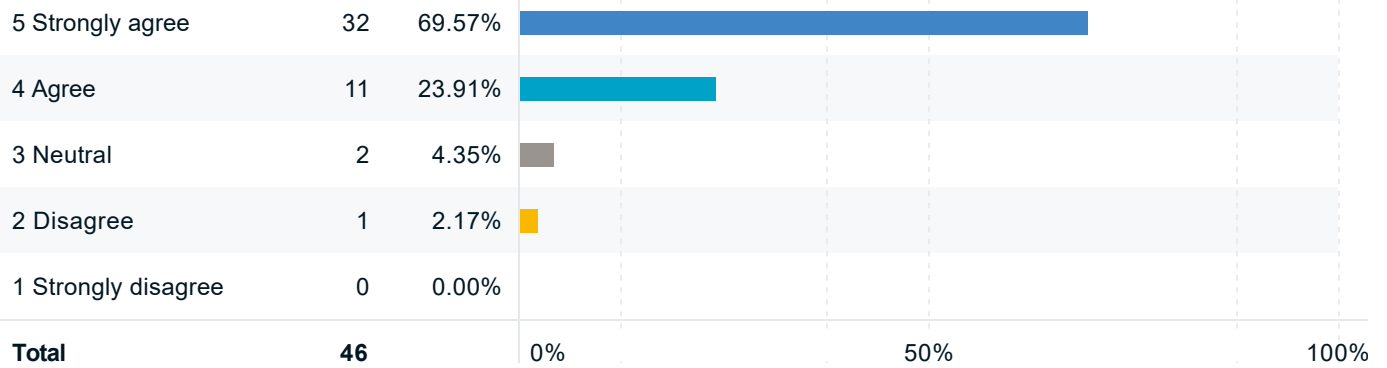

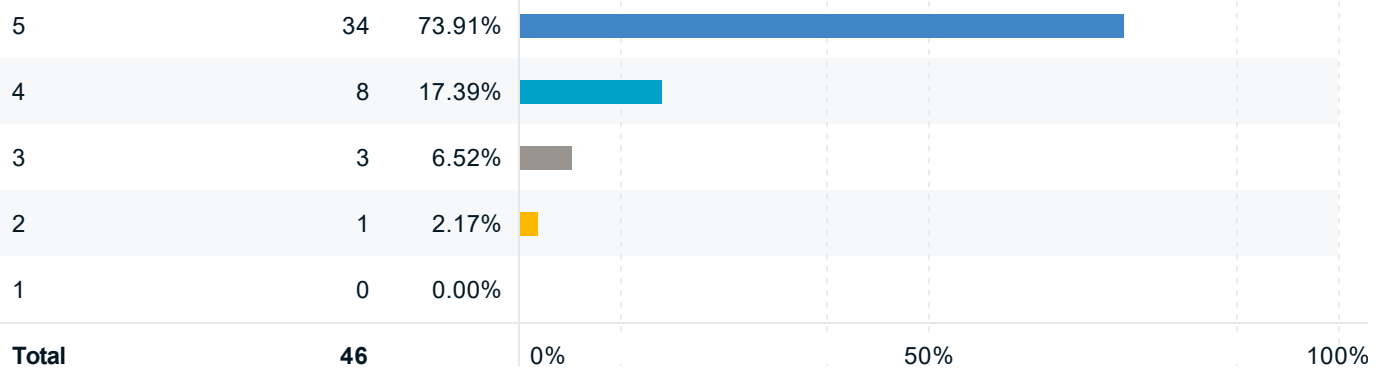
